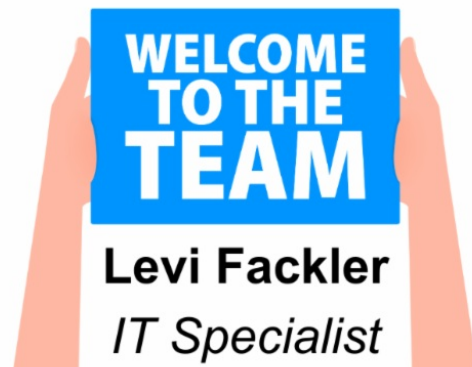

- Turn on Multifactor Authentication whenever you can, this creates a bigger wall of protection on your accounts.
- Keep software and devices updated. Turn on automatic updates as some are to strengthen the program's security.

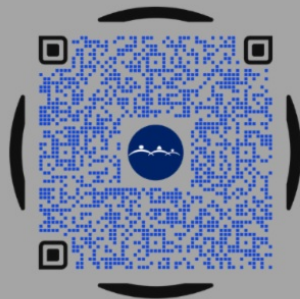

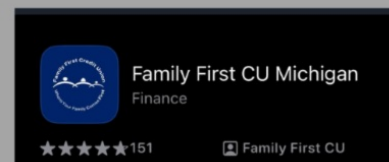
